

RIOTS AT HOBOKEN FETE

150 Policemen Quell Fights at Religious Festival

HOBOKEN, N. J., Sept. 5—Two street riots broke out tonight during the final stages of a three-day religious festival here.

Participants in the festival of the Madonna of the Martyrs, an Italian celebration, first clashed with a group of Puerto Ricans at 8:30 P. M. at the corner of Adams and Fifth Streets and in a few moments the whole area was embroiled in a pummeling, shouting free-for-all. Several blocks away, at Willow Avenue and Ninth Street, another clash started at about the same time.

One hundred and fifty policemen quelled the disturbances. Several persons were arrested on charges of disorderly conduct and a score were reported to be suffering from minor injuries, although no one was hospitalized.
